



MAN Nutzfahrzeuge receives major order for 350 trucks

Belgian-based H. Essers Group has placed a large order for no fewer than 350 vehicles with MAN, thus confirming its confidence in the German engineering company with whom the group has collaborated for more than 15 years.
