## **Readers' competition "The best commercial vehicles in 2003": MAN is victorious in the king's class**

The survey of readers of Euro Transport Media-Verlag ETM in Stuttgart has confirmed it yet again: MAN's TGA and Neoplan's Starliner are right at the top of the bill among readers. Over 10 000 readers took part in the survey carried out for the seventh time by the publications "lastauto omnibus", "Fernfahrer" and "trans aktuell" in conjunction with DEKRA. In the so-called king's class for heavy-duty, long-distance trucks with a permissible weight of 40 tonnes MAN's TGA came in first. MAN's TGA was also came in right at the top in the category for tippers up to 32 tonnes. In the premium class among coaches, the high-liner coaches, NEOPLAN's Starliner won the title.

The results of the survey show just how popular and recognised MAN's TGA is among readers. Launched in spring 2000, it has already come out top among voters in the long-distance class for the third time in succession. The second MAN TGA among the participants was clearly confirmed as the best MAN: it too triumphed among the heavy-duty building-site vehicles.

The success of the MAN Nutzfahrzeuge Group was rounded off by the Neoplan Starliner in the category for high-liner coaches. Neoplan has been able to record this success for the fifth time in succession.

MAN's victorious vehicles will be presented to hundreds of thousands of commercial vehicle fans in a grand procession at the Truck Grand Prix at the Nürburgring from July 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup>.
