MAN B&W Diesel: further Diesel power plant for Fuerteventura

The MAN B&W Diesel Group will set up a further Diesel power plant for the Las Salinas power supply station on the Canary Island of Fuerteventura. The current Spanish supplier ENDESA Generacion S.A. (Madrid) placed the order for the power plant, which will be set up in the island's capital Puerto del Rosario. In addition, the two groups agreed upon an extensive service partnership for all power plants set up by MAN B&W Diesel for ENDESA on the Canary Islands of Lanzarote, La Palma and Fuerteventura, as well as on the Balearic Island of Ibiza and in the autonomous Spanish towns Ceuta and Melilla in North Africa. This agreement includes long-term maintenance and spare-parts supply of the power stations with a total output of approx. 300 Megawatt by MAN B&W Diesel.

The large-bore Diesel engine of the 18V48/60 type, which was now ordered for the Las Salinas power station on Fuerteventura, will provide electric power generation of approx. 19 Megawatt for islanders and holiday makers. The power station is expected to supply power from the end of 2004. This is the tenth engine of this series which MAN B&W Diesel will have delivered to the ENDESA power supplier.
