



## MAN Group participates in donations and support activities for flood victims in South Asia

Munich, Jan. 5, 2005

**The MAN Group will participate with assistance in the amount of a 6-digit Euro amount in donation campaigns for the flood victims in South Asia. This assistance will both include a financial contribution as well as material resources for local support.**

As an initial short-term assistance, MAN Nutzfahrzeuge (Commercial Vehicles) donates two buses for public transportation and two semitrailer tractors with complete semitrailers for the transport of aid supplies to the disaster areas. To enable a short-term use of the vehicles at the respective locations, MAN Nutzfahrzeuge accesses local vehicles of the subsidiary MAN Truck & Bus in Malaysia. The total value of these immediate help measures amounts to roughly € 300,000.

Moreover, employees of MAN representatives in the affected regions evaluate, how far further concrete local help projects could be directly supported. This particularly applies to Indonesia, the country most affected by the effects from the seaquake and where particularly the group companies MAN Ferrostaal and MAN TURBO are active. The measures are mostly intended to restore the basis of subsistence of the survivors in the entire disaster region.

Also employees of the MAN Group contribute to the donation campaigns. A corresponding call of the workers' council already occurred.

We will publish further details concerning cash and material donations of the MAN Group for Tsunami victims in South Asia in the coming week.
